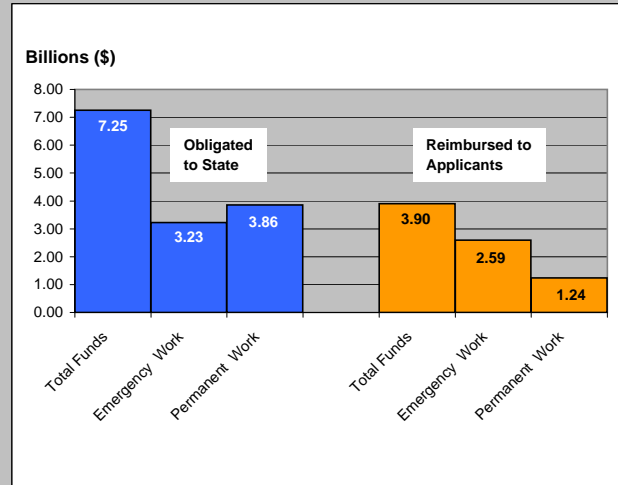

Summary of State-Wide PA Funding



Continued Support of Louisiana Recovery FEMA Public Assistance Weekly Update

- Nearly \$500K in Public Assistance funding was obligated to Holy Cross School for repairs to the Central Services and High School buildings.
- Over \$1M in Public Assistance funding was obligated to the Louisiana Technical College for repairs to buildings at the Slidell and Collier Campuses.
- Over \$2.6M in Public Assistance funding was obligated to the City of New Orleans for the replacement of furniture and equipment at the District Attorney's Office, building repair at the Templeman Prison. Funding was also obligated for the surfacing and repaving of roadways, driveways, curbs, gutters and driveway aprons in the Lakeview neighborhood and the Lower Ninth Ward.
- Over \$1.2M in Public Assistance funding was obligated to the Recovery School District for repairs to building 'B' at the Shaw Elementary School.
- Over \$2.1M in Public Assistance funding was obligated to the Roman Catholic Church/Archdiocese of New Orleans for repairs to building 'C' at the Immaculate Heart of Mary School.
