What are the steps I should follow to return home after a wildfire? The first step is to check if you are eligible to return. FEMA will provide information on the status of your property and the area. You should also check with your local emergency management agency for any restrictions or requirements. Once you are cleared to return, you should follow the instructions of the emergency management agency and the local law enforcement. You should also make sure that your property is safe and that you have all the necessary supplies and documents.
