Start today and create an account.

Submit SF-424 in **Grants.gov**.

The application process starts on Grants.gov! Search "Cybersecurity" to find DHS-23-GPD-137-00-01.

Receive email confirming application validation.

You're in! We're verifying eligibility.

Receive email with tracking number.

Your application is under review. Once approved, you will proceed in a second, separate database called ND Grants to complete the application process. You'll reference this tracking number.

Receive email to create profile in ND Grants. For questions on NDgrants, please contact FEMA at FEMA-SLCGP@fema.dhs.gov

Congratulations, you're eligible! Now create your profile in ND Grants. From now on, all communications happens in FEMA's portal.

Receive email that your application is released for you to complete.

You're almost there! Review your application carefully. Once you click submit, the system cannot accept revisions or updates.
